ROBBERY/CARJACKING OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) who robbed a U.S. Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carrier and stole the Letter Carrier's vehicle.

On Monday, December 28, 2020, at approximately 9:55 P.M., a USPS Letter Carrier was assaulted during a carjacking while delivering mail from a rented vehicle described as a white Chrysler van (pictured above, right). The incident occurred near the 2300 block of Paul Avenue NW in the Riverside neighborhood of Atlanta, GA. The suspect vehicle, described as a small red or burgundy SUV (pictured above, left), was observed driving through the area prior to the robbery. The suspect(s) fled the area via Spink Street NW while driving the SUV and the stolen Chrysler van.
